

## 1-Service Talking Points

1. What main changes will occur when we go to 1 service on March 13 at 10am?
  - a. **Masks will still be required** in adult and kids' church **per city ordinance**.
  - b. Adults will **no longer have to register online beginning with the March 13 service**, but as we have always done, **parents will still register their kids on arrival as part of our Plan to Protect and pick up process**.
  - c. We will use a **modified social distancing plan** through March to ease us into this new reality. We know that this adjustment will be easy for some and challenging for others, but we just want to be sensitive to where you are at and what you are comfortable with.
    - i. You can sit where you want on Sunday mornings.
    - ii. For the month of March, a **few back rows will be available for those who prefer full social distancing seating** (and the youth room will be available if those rows get filled).
    - iii. We will ask each party to **put down one of the 'flaps'** when they sit down to provide **one empty seat between each party**. If you are comfortable having someone sit next to you, this is optional.
2. Other things to know
  - a. Attenders will not be actively pre-screened (no one will ask you questions) but attenders will **passively pre-screen themselves** by answering the standard list of questions **that** will be posted **as you enter** (similar to what you often see in other public places like grocery stores).
  - b. We have installed the **highest efficiency filters** available throughout our building's air conditioning system.
  - c. We will **continue to fog** the chairs, restrooms, and kids' areas/toys using high-tech electrostatic sprayers that kill 99% plus germs.
  - d. **Plexiglass** for the speaker and singers will continue to be used until we no longer **are required to** wear masks.
  - e. **All parking lots and entrances will be available** for use when coming and going.
